Manipur, a small state in north-east India, has been witnessing violent ethnic conflict in which over 120 lives have been tragically lost and more than 50,000 individuals displaced from their ancestral homes since May 2023.

This crisis, fueled by territorial disputes between the majority ethnic group and the minority Kuki-Zo tribal groups, continues with no immediate resolution in sight. The minority Kuki-Zo tribal groups have been persecuted and driven out of their ancestral homes and are in dire need of humanitarian assistance. Two Kuki-Zo women were paraded naked and one of them raped by a majority meitei mob on May 4th.

The state government headed by the Chief Minister Biren Singh and the national government headed by Narendra Modi are unwilling to quell the violence. *They are complicit in this carnage.* Our mission is to stand with the tribal victims who lost their lives and homes, provide humanitarian aid and relief, and plant seeds of peace and reconciliation amidst this turmoil.
